

History S.C.F.N.A.

1967 November - first meeting; Cotati, Ca. for six months then moved to Sebastopol for next 3½ years then folded. Average attendance 4 people; met on Wed. night

1971 June - next meeting started - first in San Rosa - met Fri. night - still going (but different locations). 8-10 people in attendance.

1972 1 meeting av. attend. 8-10

1973 2 meetings av. attend. 10-15

1974 4 meetings av. attend. 10-20

1975 5 meetings av. attend. 10-25

Hosted 5th World Convention; 3-4 hundred people, profit approx. \$1500

1976 7 meetings av. attend. 25-50

1977 7 meetings av. attend. 25-50

1978 7 meetings av. attend. 50-100

1979 12 meetings av. attend. 100-150

Convention - 500-550 attendance - 2900 prof.

1981 13 meetings 150-200 av. attend

1982 12 meetings 200 av. attend

1983 15 meetings 200-250 av. attend

Previous to 1976 area/regional representation
was Northern California Intergroup.

A.S.C. formed in '76 to represent area
code 707. This proved to be too large
an area geographically speaking so in
'83 A.S.C.'s came about that more
accurately represented meeting concentra-
tions. Hence the creation of S.C.F.N.A.
(Sonoma County Fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous
