The Oldest KNOWN Member of N.A. in Michigan Shares that the first N.A. meeting, he is aware of, was Started in Detroit in February of 1969, on Jefferson AVe. at the Presbyterian Church. This meeting was sponsored by an N.A. Group out of Cleveland, Ohio. When he returned to that meeting a few months later he discovered the Group either dissolved or went under ground due to police harassment.

The Next meeting was Started by this member and another in June of 1975. This meeting was held in Bay City, at the Bialy Building on Wednesday Nights. Through out the Next few years meetings were Started in many other places like Riverside Center, Friendship House, Immanual Lutheran Church, Samaritan Health Center, and Trinity Episcopal Church.

IN 1977 the meeting held at the Bialy Building on Wednesday Nights was moved to the Trinity Episcopal Church Basement and is still held there. In 1979 a meeting which was being held at Riverside Center ON Sunday nights was also moved to Trinity Episcopal Church basement. These two meetings merged together to form one Group and are Known today as the Never Alone Geoup. There are Two

They heard that where MA has grown rapidly, someone has based their recovery in and committed to MA. Those two members returned to Flint with an understanding of the First Step of MA, and the autonomy of the MA Program. With these awarenesses they felt commitment to Marcotics anonymous was necessary for their recovery.

There were only three na meetings in Flint at this time; Sunday 12 pm, monday 8pm and Wednesday 8pm. a late night marathon meeting was established in a member's home. This Friday night "survivors" meeting was held there a few weeks, then started to move. It traveled, appeared here and there, and brought a feeling of deep intimacy between many who attended.

Attempted to start a daytime meeting-met four or five times. Little support.

California members returned to San Jose in early fall of '77. Meeting immediately folded at Intervention. AA saved literature.

Coulple people from Flint attended Bay City meeting at Riverside and Friendship House a few times '77-'78.

December 18, 1979 meeting started in ARID Club, 715 East St. One member worked for six weeks or so preceeding that meeting to convince the alcoholics on Club's board of directors that NA would not attract robbers, thieves or perverts to the Arid Club. Required a change in club's by-laws.

Meeting established Sundays at 10 AM. We were trying to avoid conflict with Sunday morning(11AM) meeting of AA.

Starter kit from WSO ordered previous to first meeting.

Irratic attendance through the first year. One trusted servant, no PI.

Second meeting established Tuesdays at midnight. Greater participation and support than daytime meeting.

Sunday meeting change to 12 noon.

In '80-'81 several meetings started in(2)T-C's and (1)drop-im didn't work, folded, broke traditions.

Received Grey Book? 1981 Feb-March?

Meeting started us ing Book, reading and reviewing. Finally folded due to lack of support and no trusted servants.

Flint General Hospital meeting started Monday and Wednesday nights. This was the first real attempt at H&I, PI or outreach.

Used AA Big Book and some NA pamphlets, recommended AA meetings to addicts.

1981 two members attempted a hotline in the summer for three months. Answering service and drop-in center numbers were broadcast over TV and radio public service announcements. No one called the answering service number, some were received by drop-in but no one followed up on them. Some people were referred to AA.

December 1981: Monday night meeting moved out of Flint General into St. Andrews Church.

Discussion centered around whether to move to a location where there was already an AA meeting or a place where no meeting had previously existed. Following AA
