(<u>HELP</u>) Yes you! Old members and new. Bucks County in the last two years has gone from 15 meetings down to 7, maybe 6. This is a serious problem for N.A. in Bucks County.

If something is still missing in your program, then taking a simple committment may be the answer!

We need people, you, to do little tasks like making coffee and welcoming the newcomer. We need Secretary's, Treasures, and Group Representatives. We need people to chair meetings, take hotline calls, and hang posters.

Nothing ensures recovery better than Service to our fellow addicts. By taking just one committment you can make all the difference. Service has helped many people strengthen their own program as well as the fellowship.
