My name is Eddie and I am an addict. I'm the third oldest of twelve children. I started using when I was ten or twelve years old. I began sniffing glue, the glue led me to wine and beer. That led me to pills and then to herion and meth.

When my addiction started it was fun, it promised me everything and left me with nothing. Early in my addiction I began to steal, lie and be just plain dishonest. In all that I've done I think about the people that I hurt most of all and it usually was the people that really cared for me...such as my mom, dad, brothers, sisters girlfriend, and even my children. I went through alot of abuse myself before I finally came to the point where I knew I needed help and that I couldn't do it alone. After all these years I did what I should done years aga...I dropped my image, reached out and asked for help... I was so full of hurt and pain, and just plain tired.

In january of 1987 I was accepted into the STEP Theraputic Community at P.I.C.C. at first because I didn't know any other way but my way. So that meant being born again. All I really knew is that I was tired of my life the way it was and that I really wanted to change. At first I would go to the N.A. meetings and say nothing, by doing this there was no change in me and the meetings were a bore. I also attended group therpy in order to deal with myself because all my life I've been running from myself...I had gotten to the point that I thought I was put on this earth to be an addict, I really believed that I was trapped and there was no way out.

Since my involvement in the N.A. fellowship, I have found a way out and I can be free of this addiction. As long as I keep coming back...one day at a time and stick with the winners, I'll be a winner. Today I have real friends and I can go to a meeting and say look, "I have a problem can you help me?" I face my problems today and I'm not ashamed of asking for help. Today I can honestly say that I like Eddie. My relationship with my girl and my children is growing and it feels great. I realize that I have a long way to go, but if I continue to do what I'm doing one day at a time, I get better. And by the grace of God I will get better...I am a miracle.
