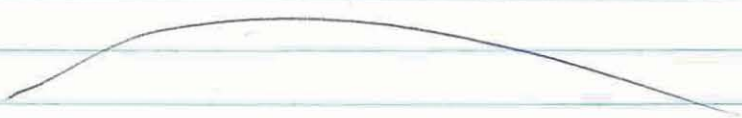

N.A. Area Service Meeting

Norristown, Pa. Feb. 8, 1981

The meeting opened at 2:00 with a reading of the Traditions. The first thing discussed was a change of location for the Area service meeting. We can no longer hold it at the Norristown YMCA. A vote was taken and it was decided that we would look for a place in the Philadelphia area.

The Area service Meeting scheduled for March 8, will be held at the church on the mall in Plymouth Meeting.

Public Relations- Pete reported that 20 high schools have been contacted and literature has been sent out to them. He thinks that by next month they will be interested in setting up speaking engagements.

The posters are doing well. They have been posted in store windows and other places. Newcomers have seen them, called the Hotline and made it to a meeting. They are working.
