

N. A. Area Service Meeting

Plymouth Meeting, Pa. March 8, 1981

The meeting opened at 2:00 with a reading of the Traditions, the Serenity Prayer, and a moment of silence for the still suffering addict.

Public Relations- Pete reported that he has set up speaking engagements with two high schools. Work on the story for the Bulletin should be starting soon. Testers are still being distributed.

Literature- Rich reported that we collected \$190 from literature sold last month. We owe World Services \$40. We donated \$21 worth of starter kits. Our present balance \$35.96. We have \$470 worth of literature on hand.

Prisons and Institutions- John D was not present to give his report.

Treasury- Bob reported that we had \$67.86 after the phone bill was paid.

1981 Convention- We now have 89 registrations. We are still short \$1,000 for the deposit for Trenton State. Everyone was asked to register as soon as possible.

Regional Service Meeting- John reported that a big question at the meeting was; If Harrisburg makes a bid for the World Convention next year, what will become of the 3rd East Coast Convention? It was decided that our area would back Harrisburg with their bid. A motion was passed that no major N.A. function within 100 miles of any other function during the period specified by World Convention bidding requirements. It was also decided that Regional Service will defer any decision about changes in the East Coast Convention until it is discussed by other areas. Guido resigned as Regional Service Representative and George R. will take his place.

Next there was a long discussion on changing the 90 day waiting period for new groups to be recognized by Regional Service. A motion was passed to recognize and add to the waiting list any new meeting that meets the requirements in the Traditions. We will suggest to them to refer to the Service manual.

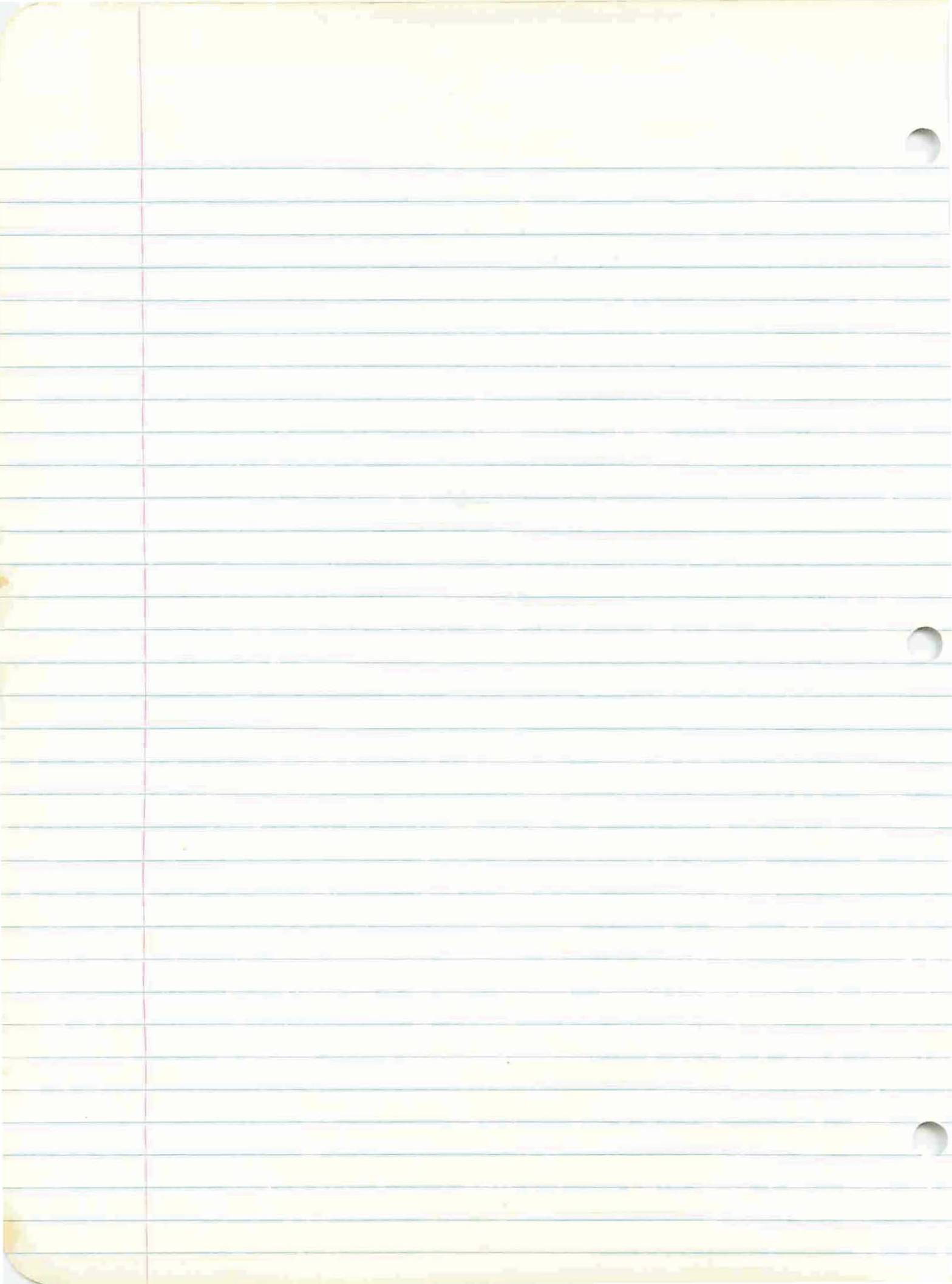
