This is to introduce to the participants in WCNA 14 and all concerned members of Narcotics Anonymous, the World Service Council International Affairs Sub-Committee (IAC).

The IAC was formed at WSC 84 in response to the needs and growing concerns of the Fellowship outside the Continental United States. This need was highlighted by the persistent request for guidance from the European Fellowship. As a result the Committee, when setting its aims, made a European Service Conference a priority.

In addition, the IAC, at its inception, set forth the following aims:
1) To compile a more comprehensive directory for regions outside the Continental U.S. and accelerate the process of registering groups.
2) To arrange an annual meeting at WCNA where members from outside the U.S. could highlight problems and share ideas.
3) To promote unity through exchange of newsletters, etc.

4) To promote growth through the availability of Hospitals/Institutions and Public Information data.

5) To investigate the feasibility, possibly through a separate committee, of translating literature to languages used in countries where N.A. exists.6) To present to the WSC, reports from regions unable to attend.

That's a big order. We four IAC members here in New York have suddenly realized how big. WE NEED HELP.

Now that the fanfare and excitement of the 1st European Service Conference, held in Dublin, Ireland, is past we have to get down to the less glamorous and often tedious work involved in the actualization of these goals.

Further, as an adjunct to these goals, we are committed to two more international service conferences this year (prior to WSC 85) - one Canadian and one for Latin America.
