If the board of trusties has a conflict on an issue for a vote they must have a solid  $^{2}/_{3}$  majority amoung themselves. If this is not me//, their vote would be obstained and that 2, the board members would unite their vote, and follow the same  $^{2}/_{3}$  majority police as the board of trustiees.

We feel that with these votes dissolved and minimized the group consceince of Narcotics Anonymous will make itself obvious.
