REPORT FROM PHILADELPHIA AREA SERVICE ADHOC COMMITTEE FORMED TO INVESTIGATE POSSIBLE TRADITION VIOLATIONS

ON THURSDAY, MAY 15TH, MEMBERS OF THE ADHOC COMMITTEE ATTENDED THE SOUTH PHILADELPHIA GROUP CONSCIOUS MEETING. WE INFORMED THEM OF ACCUSATIONS MADE AT AN AREA LEVEL REGARDING TRADITION VIOLATIONS IN THEIR H AND I COMMITMENTS. DURING THIS MEETING IT BECAME AWARE TO THE COMMITTEE THAT THE MAIN ISSUE IN QUESTION WAS THE GROUP'S PHILOSOPHY OF DRAWING THEIR RECOVERY FROM LITERATURE OTHER THAN NARCOTICS ANONYMOUS.

IT WAS BROUGHT TO THE GROUPS ATTENTION THAT THIS PRACTICE IS IN DIRECT VIOLATION OF OUR TRADITION AND THAT THEIR ACTIONS ARE AFFECTING OTHER GROUPS AND NA AS A WHOLE.

AFTER THIS MEETING, IT WAS EVIDENT THAT THE GROUP WAS GOING THROUGH A TURMOIL WITHIN ITSELF. A MAJORITY OF THE GROUP CONSCIOUS WAS WILLING TO ADHERE TO NA PRINCIPLES, BUT THERE STILL EXISTED MANY STRONG WILLED MEMBERS WHO WERE HOLDING ON TO THEIR OLD RECOVERY THROUGH OUTSIDE LITERATURE.

AFTER THE REGIONS ACTION TO REMOVE THEIR GROUP FROM THE REGIONAL MEETING LIST, THE ADHOC COMMITTEE WAS CONTACTED BY THE GROUP'S SECRATARY AND ASKED TO ADDRESS THE GROUP CONSCIOUS AGAIN. MANY OF THE SOUTH PHILA MEMBERS WERE DEEPLY UPSET OF THE REGIONS ACTION TO REMOVE THEM FROM THE LIST. THIS ANGER DOMINATED THE VOICE OF THE CONSCIOUS FOR THE MOST PART OF THE SECOND MEETING. IT WAS CLEARLY EVIDENT THOUGH THAT THE GROUP WAS WILLING TO PUT EFFORT INTO CHANGE, AND EVEN SOME OF THE STRONG WILLED MEMBERS WERE BECOMING A LITTLE MORE OPEN-MINDED.

THE GROUP HAS SINCE TAKEN POSITIVE ACTION TO CONFORM TO NA PRINCIPLES. THE GROUP CONTACTED THE LITERATURE CHAIRPERSON AND PURCHASED THE REMAINING STOCK OF BASIC TEXTS. OUT OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE GROUP AND H AND I MEETINGS ATTENDED. NO DIRECT VIOLATION OF TRADITION WAS FOUND. EDUCATION OF NA PHILOSHY TO THEIR GROUP SEEMS TO HAVE HAD AN IMPACT.

PAST EXPERIENCE HAS SHOWN US THAT A "DO NOTHING" ATTITUDE ONLY MANIFESTS AND FESTERS IN THE FORM OF DISUNITY AND ISOLATION. ALL GROUPS NEED TO ACQUIRE AN ATTITUDE OF FORGIVNESS, LOVE, PATIENCE, AND TOLERENCE SO THAT OUR AREA FELLOWSHIP CAN GROW THROUGH THIS ISSUE AND BECOME MORE UNIFIED. THE RESENTMENT NEEDS TO DIE.

THE ADHOC COMMITTEE CONCLUDES THE NEED FOR CONTINUED EDJCATION AND SUPPORT FROM THE AREA. WE AS AN AREA NEED TO AID THIS GROUP IN THEIR TRANSITION AND HELP MAKE THEM FEEL APART OF, INSTEAD OF APART FROM.
