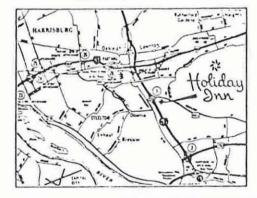

#### REGIONAL EXECUTIVE MEETING REPORT

The Executive meeting was held on Saturday, February 2, 1991 at 3:00pm. The Chair opened the meeting with a moment of silence, followed by the Serenity prayer and the reading of the 12 Traditions.

Topics of discussion were the dissolving of Sub-committees no longer serving their purpose, due to the lack of support on the Regional floor.

The following Sub-committees are Phoneline, Public Information, Lit Review, Cleansheet and Unity.

It was stated that the Phoneline be handle thru Public Information since a new phoneline installation is being considered. It is now the responsibilty of PI and will be handled thru that sub committee.

Lit Review was discussed, it was given a 60 day extension, if by the next Regional, no activity or support is given. It will be motioned to be dissolved.

Cleansheet and Unity were combined into one Sub-committee. A central place for review, distribution and meetings were discussed using the PSO as its central place to do all of this.

The other topic discussed was the WORLD BID for 1994. A committee will be formed and the following necessary things, a letter of INTENT from Regional be written, along with a format showing our resources to the hosting of the World Convention here in Philadelphia. JR volunteered his time to look into contacting people for Wformation.

A Motion was brought to Suspend Regional conventions for a year. the Intent was to refocus our intentions and adjust our focus to have activities that are service oriented and not EGO oriented.

Policy/Convention meets 2/20/91. A reminder that the Executive Committee oversees the activity of the convention.

All accounts will be audited starting from 19/89. A private firm may do the audit, it will then give suggestions and recommendations to the account status.

JAC needs a Treasurer's position.
