

## RIVERFRONT AREA POLICY

1. If a person has expressed interest & if he or she is responsible we take a vote without he or she being there.
2. Clean time be waived according to the individual.
3. That no special interest group be allowed to exist in the Riverfront Area (see definition)
4. That the area minutes contain time and place of all sub-committee meetings in their report.
5. That the makers of all motions remain anonymous.
6. Abstentions count not as a vote.
7. Any motion with a 1/3 abstention be sent back to groups for more information.

Both policies shall stand: Abstentions will not affect the outcome of vote unless there is a 1/3 abstention at which time the motion will go back to the groups.

8. That all recovering addicts involved within the N.A. service structure be required to serve and attend only the 12 step fellowship of N.A. If this requirement cannot be met they should step down from their positions.
9. To continue to celebrate the Riverfront Area's birthday on the 1st weekend in August of each year.
10. If there is not more than 1/2 the groups in the area in favor of a motion to be phone voted, the motion will not be carried.
11. All Riverfront Area money be turned over to the treasurer and be kept in the Riverfront Area bank account until needed by the area, committee etc.
12. That the Area chair or co-chair be relinquished from the duty of breaking tie votes on motions voted in group conscience.
13. That Area Service Treasurer include the amount of money owed to the Area in their report. (Excluding names of groups, committees, etc.)
14. There to be no group conscience meeting during area service.

15. There is to be no physical, violent behavior at area service anyone exhibiting such behavior shall be asked to leave and the GSR's group conscience be given to the Area Chair.

SUB-COMMITTEE POLICY (RIVERFRONT AREA)

1. Sub-committee's elect chairs & co-chairs within their committees
2. That all H& I commitments that the groups have in the Riverfront Area be turned over to the H& I Committee.
3. That all group liasons serve for 1 year.
4. That all members of the H & I have a vote. Member (defined) - a person who has attended 2 or more H & I meetings consecutively.
5. That the Unity Committee hold a workshop every other month starting April 1990.
6. GSR's handling commitments submit a report as to how commitments are being held and if a clear message is being carried.
