

#### Hotels WCNA 29 will be held at the Georgia World Congress Center.

1> Marriott Marquis • Deluxe hotel serves as convention headquarters, will host some of the evening events, and is located seven blocks from the Convention Center. Rooms: \$115-single/double, \$125-triple/quad, Suites (limited availability): \$198-one bedroom, \$298-two bedroom.

- 2> Hilton Located eight blocks from the Convention Center and just across the street from the Marriott, this co-headquarter hotel is great for those who want to be close to the evening action. Rooms: \$115-single/double, \$135-triple, \$155-quad.
- 3> AmeriSuites This all-suites hotel located seven blocks from the convention center, features kitchenettes with microwaves, coffeemakers, refrigerators, separate living/bedroom areas, free continental breakfast, and \$5/night guest parking. Suites are \$99 single/double, \$109 triple, \$119 quad.
- 4> Days Inn For the budget conscience attendee, this economy hotel located 5 blocks from the Convention Center offers perfectly clean accommodations with balconies. All rooms are \$90.
- 5> Embassy Suites This quaint European-style boutique hotel overlooking Centennial Olympic Park, offers beautifully decorated suites and is located one block from the Convention Center. Suites include microwave, refrigerator, coffeemaker, one king or two double beds, a sleeper sofa in the living room, and complimentary cooked-to-order breakfast buffet for: \$129 single/double, \$149-triple/quad.
- 6> Holiday Inn This intimate newly renovated and reasonably priced hotel is located just three blocks from the Convention Center. All rooms are \$90.
- 7> Omni CNN Center This newly renovated deluxe hotel is located just across the street from the Convention Center with an atrium overlooking the CNN World Headquarters and a great food court. Rooms: \$119-single/double, \$129-triple/quad. Suites (limited availability): \$258-one bedroom, \$284-two bedroom.
- 8> Wyncham This new full-service hotel has nicely appointed deluxe rooms and is located just three blocks from the Convention Center. Rooms: \$107-single/double only (no triple/quad occupancy) om
