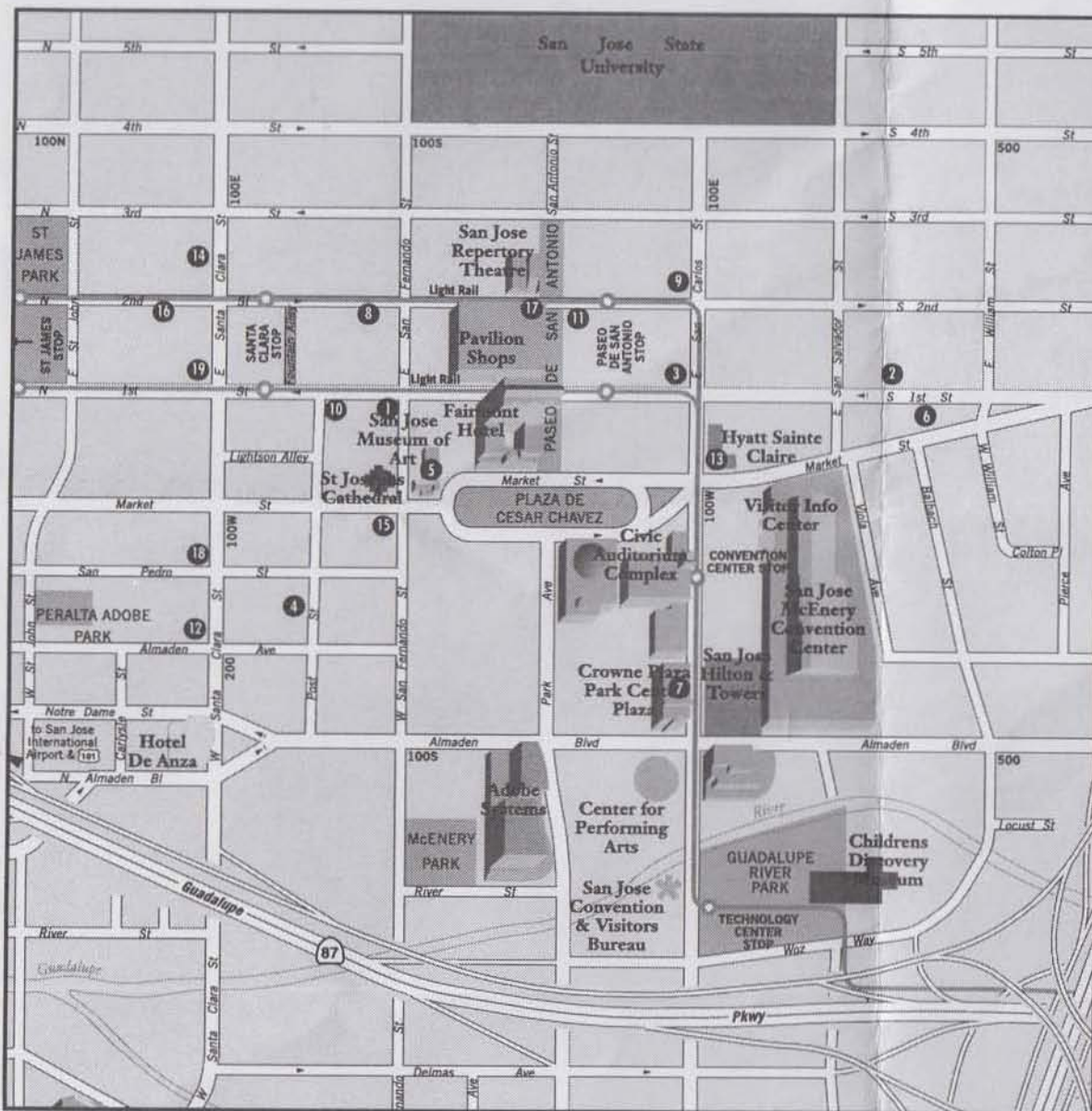

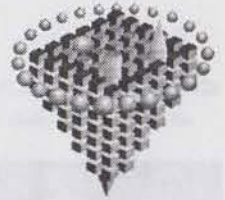

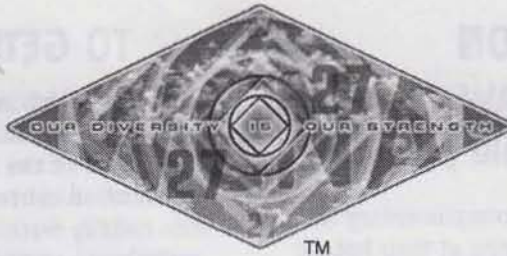

WCNA-27 PRE-CONVENTION INFORMATION NEWSLETTER

It's just about time to pack your bags and head to San Jose for the 27th World Convention of Narcotics Anonymous. Whether this is your first world convention or your 27th, this newsletter gives you general information about registration, transportation, activities/events, and other helpful hints that will enhance your convention experience. Please read it thoroughly as this information is very important to know before your arrival in San Jose. You will find more detailed information regarding the convention itself in your registration package that you will receive at the convention.

With an expected attendance of around 20,000, this will be the largest NA convention in our history. Due to the colossal size of this event, we will need to practice the principles of recovery, most important will be patience. There will be no way to avoid lines and crowds. It will be very helpful if you try to register or pick-up your pre-registration package as soon as possible after your arrival in San Jose.

We ask that you carefully review the transportation information in this newsletter. To minimize traffic jams, we have arranged shuttle transportation from many hotels to the convention center. We strongly suggest that you avoid driving your own vehicles to the convention center. If possible, use the complimentary bus service provided by WCNA-27 or the city's Light Rail Line.

We look forward to making this the best convention in the history of NA. Our aim is to make sure that everyone attending this convention carries away only fond and positive memories.

WELCOME TO SAN JOSE!!!

At the San Jose Airport you will find a **Hospitality Table** near the Baggage Claim Area. Members of the Convention Information Committee of WCNA-27 will be there to welcome you and provide you with any information you may need at that time.

Important Reminders:

- **Bring your convention confirmation with you when you register/check-in (See page 4).**
- **The pre-registration area will be located in two different places during the convention:** in the Civic Auditorium on Wednesday and Thursday, and in the McEnergy Convention Center on Friday and Saturday. For those who did not pre-register, the "on-site" registration location will be in the main lobby of the McEnergy Convention Center (see page 4).
- **Registration packages will not be split up between members of your party.** Whoever has the confirmation must pick up the package for all those who registered together (see page 4).
- **Registration badges are required** for certain events (see page 4).
- If possible, use **other means of transportation** (our free bus shuttles and the Light Rail Line) as an alternative to driving in heavy traffic (see pages 2, 3).
- Remember: **California State Law prohibits smoking** in public facilities (see page 5).
- **If you do not have a credit card, your hotel will require cash deposits for incidental charges.** (see page 6)

TRANSPORTATION

To Get from the San Jose Airport to Your Hotel

The following uptown hotels provide complimentary airport shuttle transportation for guests staying at their hotels:

Most hotel airport shuttle services run from 7:30 AM through 11:00 PM. The procedures for airport shuttle transportation to hotels are the same for all hotels that provide this service. The procedure is as follows:

- In the baggage claim area in all terminals you will find a courtesy phone with a list of the hotels that provide shuttle service. You must **call the hotel from the airport courtesy phone** to make arrangements to be picked up!
- After you have made arrangements with hotel for pick up, go outside to the pick up point. (Look for: "SHUTTLE STOP PICK UP ONLY" signs to wait for your shuttle bus.)
- All hotels located **Downtown and in Santa Clara do not provide complimentary shuttle** service. We suggest taking the **South Bay Flyer shuttle**. They charge a reasonable rate, approximately \$6.00 per person. The phone number is **(408)566-0430**. There will also be taxis available at the airport. The cost for taxis going to downtown or Santa Clara hotels is approximately \$13.00. The cost for taxis going to Sunnyvale is approximately \$17.00.

To Get from the San Francisco Airport to Your Hotel

The **South Bay Flyer (408. 566.0430)** provides direct shuttle service to the following hotels:

If you are staying in a hotel other than those mentioned above, you may take the South Bay Flyer to the San Jose Airport to get the free airport-to-hotel shuttle service provided by some of the hotels.

The approximate cost of the South Bay Flyer from San Francisco is \$17.00. You can get the South Bay Flyer Shuttle in front of the International United Airlines terminal (in front of the "No Parking" sign).

TO GET AROUND SAN JOSE:

If you're driving to the convention, we recommend that you, **park your car at your hotel and use our shuttle transportation or the Light Rail Line to get to and from the convention center**. There will be a great deal of traffic over the holiday weekend because along with our convention, a major arts and crafts show, the Talent in Tapestry Festival is occurring at the same time in San Jose. As you can imagine, with all the people expected in downtown San Jose, traffic will likely be very heavy. Using transportation other than private automobiles would be a wise choice, saving you time and some of the hassles and stress of traffic.

Complimentary Bus Shuttle Service

If you are staying in a hotel outside of the downtown area, **free bus shuttles** will be provided by WCNA-27 to take you to and from the convention center. This shuttle service begins at **8:00am, Thursday, September 3rd** and will continue throughout the convention. A copy of the shuttle schedule will be posted at the Convention Information Booth and in the lobby of all hotels on the shuttle routes. The shuttle transportation is provided on three routes as follows:

- Please make a note of the shuttle route number serving your hotel. These route numbers will remain the same throughout the convention and will be clearly marked in the front window of each bus.
- For those with tickets to the Jazz Breakfast, additional buses will depart from all hotels on the shuttle routes to the convention center at 8 am Saturday morning. Your specific scheduled pick-up time will be posted in the lobby of your hotel.
- For those with tickets to the Saturday concert, special shuttle buses will depart from outside the San Jose Arena for the concert venue immediately following the conclusion of the main meeting. **You must have a concert ticket in order to board the concert shuttle. Do not forget to bring your concert tickets with you to the Saturday Night Meeting!**
- Following the Saturday concert, additional shuttle buses will depart on Fourth Street outside the concert venue to transport attendees directly back to all hotels outside the downtown area.

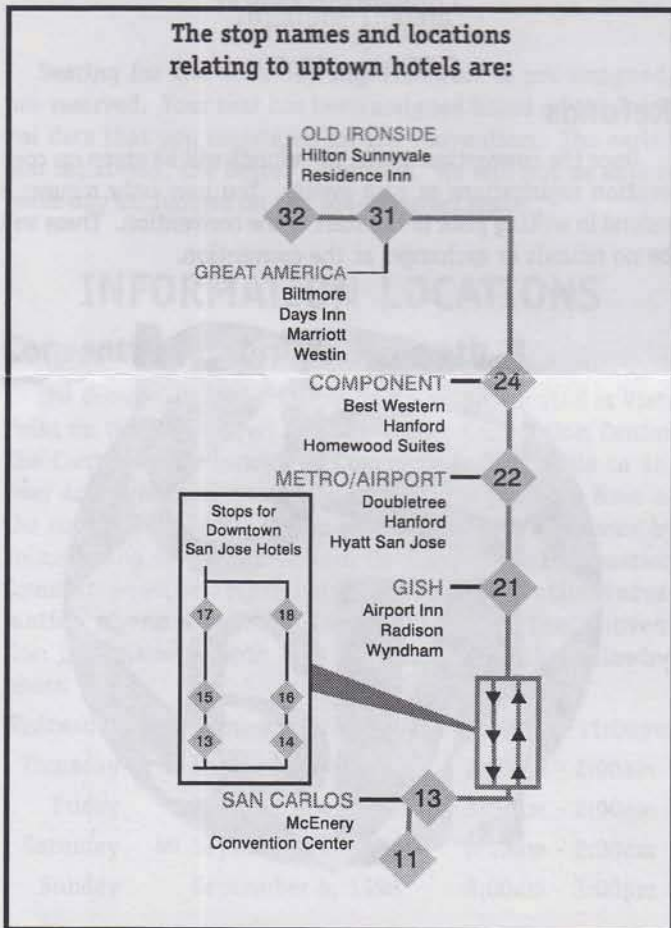
Light Rail Transportation (LRT)

The Light Rail system in San Jose is a modern, 20-mile transit system that runs from South San Jose to Paramount's Great America theme park in Santa Clara to the north. The Light Rail will connect WCNA-27 attendees to the hotels located near the airport along First and Fourth Streets, the downtown hotels, and the Convention Center. In addition, historic trolleys share a portion of the Light Rail line, circling downtown accommodations, restaurants, nightlife, attractions, and shopping.

Light Rail service is provided seven days a week from early morning to 1 am. Trains operate every 10 - 15 minutes weekdays from 5:30 am to 8 pm; every 15 minutes Saturday, Sunday and holidays; and every 30 minutes evenings.

For your convenience, WCNA-27 attendees can purchase day pass rail tickets with unlimited daily use for \$1.85 (a 25% discount) at the San Jose Convention and Visitors Bureau Information Booth located in the Main Level of the Convention Center. Riders can also purchase tickets from machines located at each Light Rail station. The machines will take \$1.00 or \$5.00 bills as well as coins, and will give change if needed. **You must purchase your ticket before boarding.**

- 101 South to the Guadalupe Parkway/87 Exit. Continue on Guadalupe Parkway/87. Take Park Avenue /San Carlos Street Exit and turn left. Turn right on Almaden Avenue. Convention Center parking entrance will be on the left.

101 Northbound

(from Gilroy, Morgan Hill, Hollister, Los Angeles):

- 101 North to San Jose. 101 intersects with 280, take the 280 North Exit. Continue on 280, take the Bird Avenue Exit, turn right. Turn right on San Carlos Street. Turn right on Almaden Avenue. Convention Center parking will be on the left.

17/880 Southbound

(from Berkeley, Oakland, Hayward, Fremont, Milpitas):

- 17/880 South to the Coleman Avenue Exit. Turn left on Coleman Ave. Coleman becomes Market Street (toward downtown San Jose). Turn right on San Carlos Street. Turn left on Almaden Avenue. Convention Center parking will be on the left.

17 Northbound

(from Santa Cruz, Los Gatos):

- 17 North to Downtown San Jose/280 South Exit. Take 280 South to the Vine Street/Almaden Avenue exit. Turn left onto Almaden Avenue. Convention parking will be on the right.

680 Southbound

(from Sacramento, Concord, Walnut Creek, Livermore, Milpitas):

- 680 South until it becomes 280 North at the 101 interchange. Continue on 280, take the Bird Avenue Exit, turn right. Turn right on San Carlos Street. Turn right onto Almaden Avenue. Convention Center parking will be on the left.

Parking Information for the Convention Center

If you plan to drive to the convention, please follow these recommendations to assist you with parking:

- Follow signs off main highways for convention parking.
- Use the parking lots that are located at the San Jose McEnery Convention Center and/or the Arena. Downtown lots can also be used for your parking needs.
- There are no in-and-out parking privileges. If you leave the parking lot, you will have to pay again if you want to return to the lot.
- Approximate cost of parking is \$5.00 per day at the Convention Center and \$7.00 per day at the Arena and most of the parking lots.

PRE-REGISTRATION

Once you have settled into your hotel room, it's time to get your registration package containing your name badge, pre-paid event tickets, pre-registration gift, and your convention program guide. At this time you will also be able to pick up your pre-ordered T-shirts and mugs. Depending on availability, you might be able to purchase additional special event tickets.

Even though you have pre-registered you can only get your registration package and merchandise if ordered, by confirming your registration on site. Here's how you do that:

The only way we will give out packages to pre-registrants is if:

- **The person picking up the package is the main registrant and has the confirmation on hand or a valid photo identification.** In other words, the registration package is put in the name of the person who sent in the registration (the main registrant¹). If the main registrant does not have the confirmation, valid photo identification will be acceptable to receive the registration package.

OR

- **The person picking up the package is listed as an additional or other registrant and has the confirmation with them.** In other words, a person listed as an additional registrant² may pick up the registration package if he/she has the confirmation. Additional registrants will not be able to pick up the package if they do not have the confirmation in hand.
- **The person that picks up the registration package will be required to pick up the whole package for all those in their party.** For example, if you sent in a registration for 3 people, you must pick up the package for all three people. Registration packages will not be split up.

¹ Main registrant- person listed on the top of the confirmation (with address).

² Additional registrant - person listed as "other registrant" on the confirmation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

No Smoking

It is against the law to smoke in any public facility in the State of California, except in designated outdoor smoking areas or hotel rooms that were assigned as "smoking rooms." 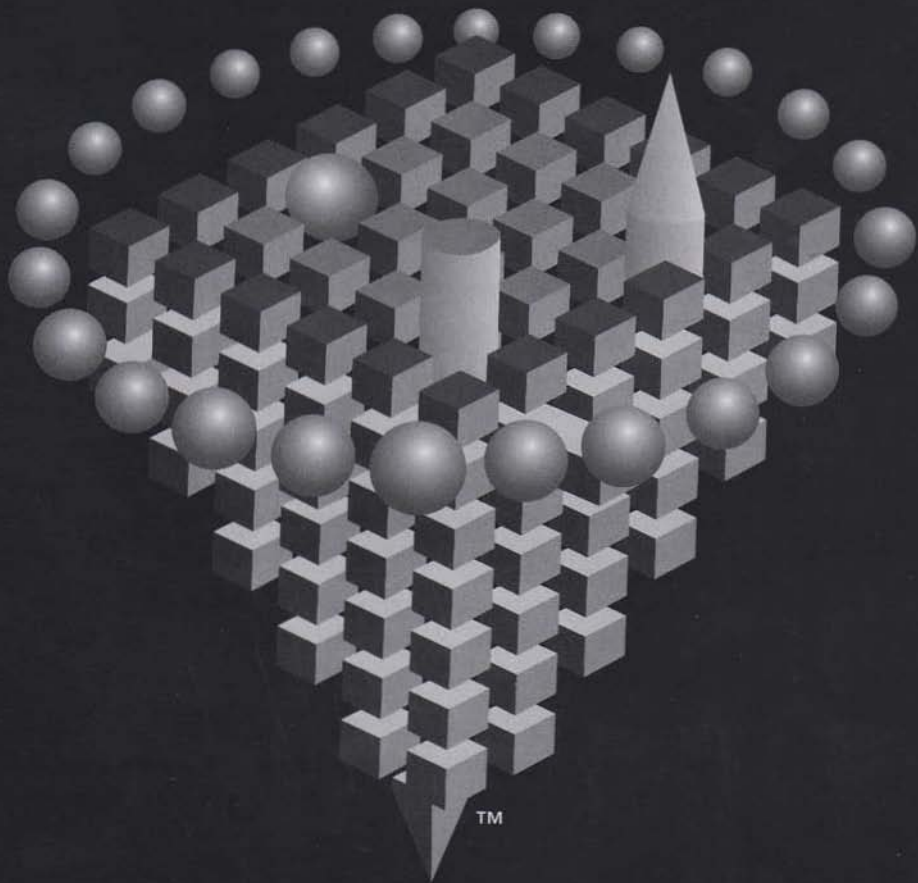

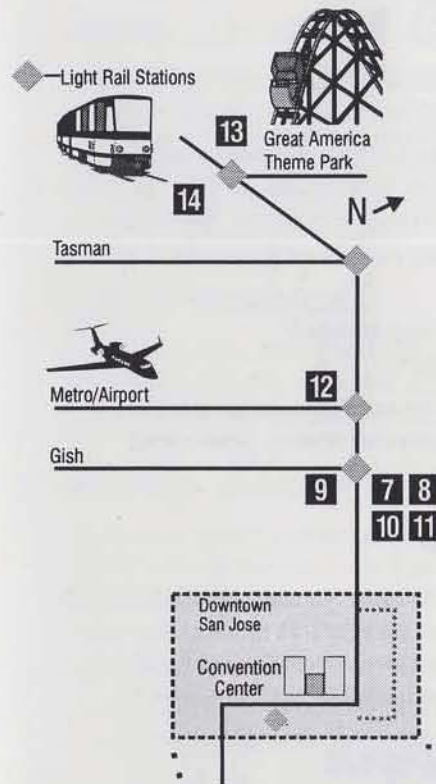

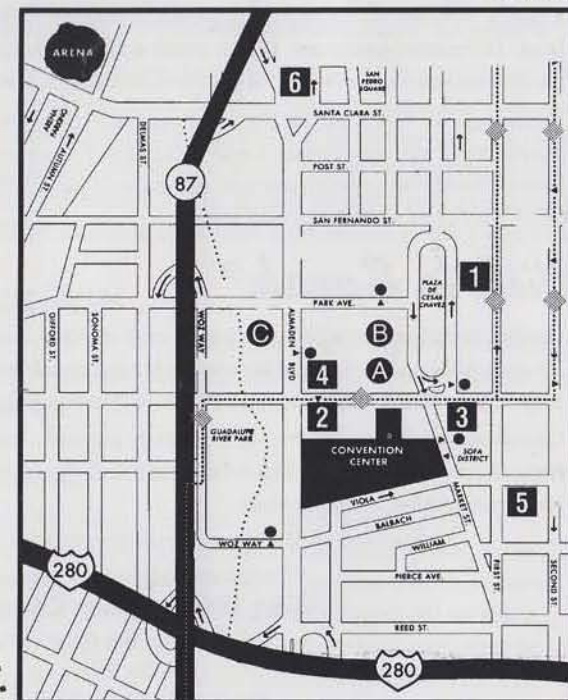
