Years of hard work have gone into achieving this goal and this
book is truly the result of a Fellowship-wide effort.

We at the World Service Office of Narcotics Anonymous are pleased to have been delegated the job of publishing Narcotics Anonymous by the World Service Conference. We are grateful to have this opportunity to be of service. We have a tremendous task before us and need your support to accomplish it.

The initial publication of our book will require a huge outlay of capital and, at present, we do not have the funds to do this. Throughout the history of Narcotics Anonymous, it has been our experience that whenever funds were needed, they were made available. Often, when the situation seemed most impossible, the miraculous happened and the money was there.

After much discussion and debate with regard to obtaining the necessary funds for the book, it was decided to print a Special Limited First Edition.
