

Originally published in 1983, this publication is commonly referred to as the "Basic Text" for recovery from addiction. In its pages, many addicts share their experience, strength, and hope about the disease of addiction and their recovery through the N.A. program. It encompasses and expands on the chapters from the N.A. White Booklet, and includes an additional chapter, "More Will Be Revealed." The personal stories of many recovering addicts are also included in order to assist new members in finding identification and hope for a better life.

N.A. White Booklet, Newly Revised Item No. 1500 Each: 1-99 copies \$.50 over 100 copies \$.40

The N.A. White Booklet was the first piece of literature written for the fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous. It contains a concise description of the N.A. program, including all of the information in pamphlets No. 1 and No. 6. The White Booklet is included in its entirety in the Basic Text, *Narcotics Anonymous*. Because the actual titles of the publications are the same, the original booklet is often referred to as the "White Booklet."

The Group Booklet Item No. 1600

This new booklet provides the information members need when they start an N.A. meeting. As a replacement for the *Starter Kit*, "The Group Booklet" offers information and guidance for new groups.

Behind The Walls Item No. 1601

This booklet is aimed at those who are currently incarcerated, and is an excellent tool to help carry the message to those addicts who are unable to attend regular meetings of Narcotics Anonymous. The booklet contains the experience of many members who found and maintained their recovery "Behind The Walls." Their words are used to illustrate some of the principles contained in our program of recovery from the disease of addiction.

The Group

Revised in 1988, "The Group" contains pertinent information that has proved its value over the years. This pamphlet includes sections on what it means to be an N.A. member, how the group takes care of its rent and other obligations, electing trusted servants, and the primary purpose of an N.A. group.



Who, What, How and Why

(I.P. No. 1)

Item No. 3101

This informational pamphlet excerpts important information from the first eight pages of the White Booklet. These sections include "Who Is an Addict?," "What Is the Narcotics Anonymous Program?," "Why Are We Here?," "How It Works," and "The Twelve Traditions of N.A." This basic information about the N.A. program serves as an effective introduction to addicts seeking recovery through the Narcotics Anonymous program and to professionals seeking information about N.A.

Another Look

(I.P. No. 5)

Item No. 3105

This pamphlet takes another look at addiction, including some "old ideas" frequently used by addicts to rationalize using drugs. In an attempt to clarify what addiction is, sections address specifically what addiction is not: "Addiction Is Not Freedom;" "Addiction Is Not Personal Growth;" "Addiction Is Not Goodwill;" "Addiction Is Not a Way of Life."

Recovery and Relapse

(I.P. No. 6)

Item No. 3106

An excerpt from the White Booklet, this pamphlet discusses the early warning signs of relapse, as well as actions that addicts can take to avoid a relapse.

Am I an Addict? (I.P. No. 7)

Item No. 3107

Questions are presented that assist individuals in answering this question for themselves. The questions range from a focus on obvious behavioral symptoms to more subtle personality changes that accompany the disease of addiction. Reading this pamphlet may help addicts to face their addiction honestly and give them hope, because it offers the solution of the N.A. program.

Just for Today

(I.P. No. 8)

Item No. 3108

There are five positive thoughts presented in this pamphlet to help recovering addicts each day. Ideal for reading on a daily basis, these thoughts provide addicts with the perspective of clean living to face each new day. The remainder of the pamphlet develops the principle of living a day at a time, encouraging addicts to trust in a Higher Power and work the N.A. program on a daily basis.

Living the Program

(I.P. No. 9)

Item No. 3109

This pamphlet provides excellent guidelines for recovering addicts who wish to keep a daily journal. It is based on the principles of daily living found in I.P. No. 8, "Just for Today," and contains a set of questions to assist recovering addicts in working the Tenth Step at the end of each day. It cautions readers not to get upset if they fail at something or feel they could have done better at specific tasks, and reminds them to live a day at a time, focusing on their growth and recovery.

Sponsorship

(I.P. No. 11)

Item No. 3111

Sponsorship is a vital tool for recovery. This introductory pamphlet helps provide an understanding of sponsorship, especially for new members. The pamphlet addresses some common questions, including what is a sponsor? How do you get a sponsor? Also included is a closing section, "How to Be a Sponsor."

The Triangle of Self-Obsession

(I.P. No. 12)

Item No. 3112

"Resentment, anger, and fear make up the triangle of self-obsession." In this pamphlet, we see how these reactions to the past, present and future are part of the disease of addiction. This pamphlet tells us that in order to recover from our addiction we need to begin taking responsibility for our own lives, our own happiness, and our own recovery.

Youth and Recovery

(I.P. No. 13)

Item No. 3113

The message of this succinct pamphlet is that recovery is possible for all addicts, regardless of their age or the extent of their drug use. It emphasizes that all addicts eventually end up at the same point of total despair, but that this is not necessary—we can begin recovering right away! Sections on hitting bottom, making decisions, peer pressure and family problems, living just for today, and a message of hope are included.

One Addict's Experience with Acceptance, Faith and Commitment

(I.P. No. 14)

Item No. 3114

This is a personal recounting of the process one addict went through in identifying his problem, beginning a program of abstinence, using a sponsor, and working the Twelve Steps.

For the Newcomer

(I.P. No. 16)

Item No. 3116

This informational pamphlet describes how Narcotics Anonymous combats the disease of addiction that is shared by all N.A. members. It sets forth the Twelve Steps, the blueprints for recovery. Information about recognizing and experiencing feelings is included, as well as suggestions to utilize a sponsor and new friends in the N.A. fellowship. All of these tools help addicts to begin and maintain their recovery.

Self Acceptance

(I.P. No. 19)

Item No. 3119

The first half of this pamphlet, "The Problem," discusses aspects of an unmanageable life, including not accepting ourselves or others. The second half of the pamphlet, "The Twelve Steps Are the Solution," outlines the process that allows recovering addicts to apply the Twelve Steps in every area of their lives in order to gain acceptance of themselves and others.

Hospitals, Institutions and the N.A. Member (I.P. No. 20) Item No. 3120

A brief introduction to N.A. hospitals and institutions (H&I) work, this pamphlet encourages N.A. members to avail themselves of the opportunity to serve. Three personal experiences are included that illustrate the fact that even though H&I work may sometimes seem intimidating, the results are consistently worth the effort.

Welcome to Narcotics Anonymous

(I.P. No. 22)

Item No. 3122

This pamphlet was written to answer questions often asked by people attending their first N.A. meeting. Its message is simple: "We have found a way to live without using drugs and we are happy to share it with anyone for whom drugs are a problem."

Staying Clean on the Outside

(I.P. No. 23)

This pamphlet is directed toward those recovering addicts who are re-entering society from a treatment or correctional setting. It outlines the basics necessary to continue their recovery while in transition. It addresses such issues as how to get involved in recovery in N.A. while still institutionalized, how to make first contacts with N.A. members, how to find and choose a sponsor, and how to get involved in personal service. A highly valuable tool for those in a hospital or institutional setting interested in developing a personal program of daily action.

"Hey! What's the Basket For?"

(I.P. No. 24)

A pamphlet describing how and why Narcotics Anonymous is self supporting. It offers a brief overview of the N.A. service structure and how it is funded. The focus is on the many services provided by our members' contributions.
