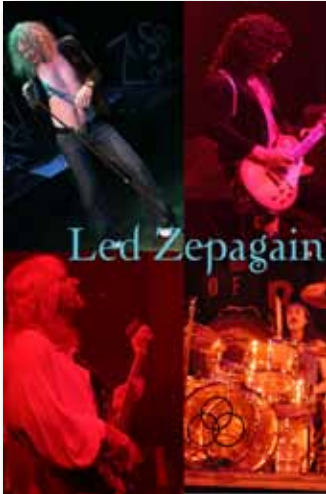

Thursday Night Rock Coffee House



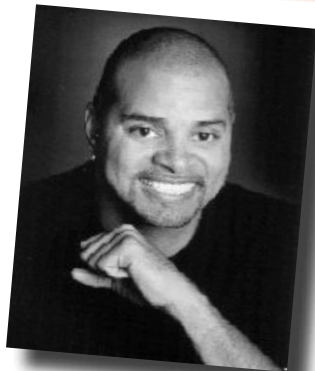

Thursday Night Comedy Show



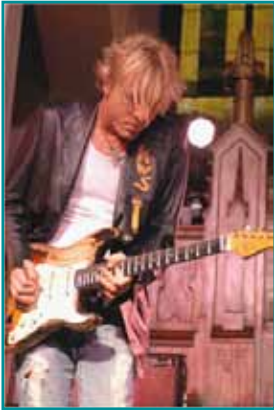

Kenny Wayne Shepherd has sold millions of albums worldwide, received four Grammy nominations, two Billboard Music Awards, two Orville H. Gibson Awards, the Blues Foundation's Keeping The Blues Alive Award, and a Blues Music

Award among many other accolades. He has had four No. 1 blues albums and a string of No. 1 mainstream rock singles.

Legendary smooth jazz musician, Brian Culbertson, is our featured guest for the jazz brunch. Culbertson began his quest in music at the age of eight on piano, adding drums at nine, trombone at ten and then bass at twelve. He grew up in Decatur, IL, loving genre-crossing jazz-pop artists such as Chicago, Blood Sweat & Tears, Tower of Power, David Sanborn, Yellowjackets, and Maynard Ferguson. With 12 albums and counting, Brian Culbertson always brings his very best.

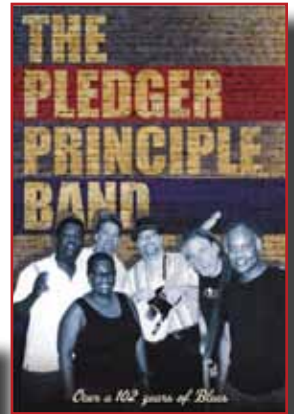

Saturday Night Coffee House

The Saturday Night Coffee House will have an overall rhythm and blues theme and will include an NA-member band. The Pledger Principle Band features Peggy P's sultry voice performing the hits of Tracy Chapman, Etta James, and many others! She'll woo the crowd and prepare us for legendary soul artists Con Funk Shun. "Love's Train" is still one of the most popular soul ballads, and they are among the heroes of funk with inventive horn arrangements and clav-guitar woven grooves, romantic ballads, and dance-party hits galore. They charted four consecutive golds and one platinum album. Their 20 hit singles included 8 top-ten R&B hits. Their hits are featured in countless rap/hip-hop samples, exposing them to a new generation.



Saturday Night Concert



Vanilla Fudge was one of the first American groups to infuse psychedelia into a heavy rock sound to create "psychedelic symphonic rock." They are best known for their dramatic, slowed-down arrangements of contemporary pop songs like their heavy-rocking, trippy and psychedelic version of The Supremes' "You Keep Me Hangin' On." After 45 years, Vanilla Fudge is still rocking in appearances like their March 2011 performance on "Late Night with Jimmy Fallon" and in US and European concerts.

Blue Oyster Cult's canon includes three stone-cold classics that will waft through the cosmos long after the sun has burned out: The truly haunting "(Don't Fear) The Reaper," the pummeling "Godzilla," and the hypnotically melodic "Burnin' for You." BÖC is often cited as a major influence by other bands such as Metallica, and BÖC is a part of VH1's countdown of the greatest hard rock bands of all time. The band members are proud of BÖC's classic sound, and are pleased to continue rocking vibrant work for their fans.
