(pg 13).

'Drink or drug' implies there is a difference among drugs of addiction. The disease is the same and using is the term which has been used in other approved material. (pg. 22)

'Patient/doctor' has a very different conotation from the more often used student/ teacher', (pg. 32)

'Sobriety' relates to recovery from alcoholism and even in the spiritual sense doesn't express 'recovering what is lost to us in our active addiction'. Consistent with the Basic Text. (pg. 27)

The nine marks on page 33 change the material to relate to our members experience with the drug methadone which noone could mastake or contest. In original, the material expresses an opinion on an outside issue, which is the methadone program and/or the treatment centers per se.

I don't know we would ever reccomend 'bars' or being comfortable in a circumstance where drugs are being used. Personaly, I pray a lot. (pg. 3).

Since membership is contingent of the dimire to stop using, all drugs would be included. (pg. 35).

Many of our members are women. (pg. 36).

We can't use brand names in our literature. (pg.41)

Group service representative. (pg. 45)

As I understand it, there is no spiritual part of the program. (pg. 58).

No need to address another program. (pg. 65) (pg. 66)
Reccomending another program by name would violate our Sixth
Tradition. (pg. 67) (pg. 76)

After sentence one, paragraph one, page 77, I would suggest adding the line, "We don't want you to get arrested because you have rushed to help someone who has drugs in their home." You can come up with something better.

Also, there needs to be a finish to the material, like: Whoever you are, whatever you have done or been, we welcome you to come and share in the good life we have found. Our concern for you is essential to our growth. We know your life will improve daily if you don't use and try our N.A. way of life. Out of our own pain and dispair, we have been led into relief from our addiction, hope for a new life caeen and the kind of love for others we can back up in our living.

The Traditions related feedback I give as a member of the World Service Board of Trustees, the rest as a member. For someone who used to be so long winded, this little feedback astounds me. But then, it is a Program of change...
