I want to thank those of you who have provided input on the trust document. We have included three new members to the working group Billy Eason, Bob McDonough, and Roy Drum. Welcome. I have included all of the input for your reference. From that input, I have extracted 5 basic concerns which appear to be common issues relative to the structure of the trust. I have listed them below in the form of an agenda so we can have some structure to the conference call scheduled for Thursday, May 30th, 6 p.m. Please call George at the Office if there are difficulties

1. There appears to be a question regarding the accuracy or inaccuracy of the background statement, or the style in which it is written. What needs to be stated in this section?
2. How does the fellowship direct the World Service Office as it administers the trust? Does the World Service Conference act as that voice? If not, how, who, or what does?
3. How should the specific assignments of the beneficiary, trustee, and trustor be done?
4. What ability, if any, should the World Service Office have to affect the trust property without prior permission of the trustor?
5. Does N.A. membership (or as a N.A. group) grant one immunity from prosecution for infringement of trust properties? If not complete immunity than in which cases does it apply?

It appears that these are some of the major issues that need to be discussed further in order to come to some agreement. Please review these questions and be prepared to discuss them. Once again thank you for your input.
