This is a little belated for your 71th birthday but I thought you might be interested in knowing of the outcome of the work of Narcotics Anonymous here in Cleveland.

The copy of the letter to the D.C. gives the broad outlines.

You will be glad to know that our last group leader is doing quite well. He has been given a complete pardon by Governor Gilligan and is now attending college in Calif on a scholarship.

Another one of our members, the big heavy set fellow who saw you years ago in New York is now working for the city of Cleveland in the Community Relations Department and is keeping the three groups going each week.

We have moved to a larger building and now have 200 private rooms along with a number of dorms, two dining rooms, a gym and a swimming pool and 7 class rooms.

We are no longer working with drug addicts but have a proposal in to Dept of HEW to operate a regional Detoxification Center in connection with our Harbor Light Center. This will pay for 40 beds to be under medical supervision.

Hope that you are feeling well, and had a happy birthday.
