

HISTORY-CHARLESTON, W. V.A.

The Charleston Central Group of Narcotics Anonymous held it's first meeting on April 30, 1979. The meeting was held at the following location:

There were six persons in attendance at this meeting.

The group met only one night a week for the first six months. The group then felt that one meeting a week was not enough, so another meeting was started on Thursdays. The group continued to meet every Monday and Thursday for six months. Their attendance was minimal, and if they had 10 recovering addicts present, they considered it a large crowd.

In July 1980, the group began to grow at a very rapid pace, requiring us to add two more meetings.

The Charleston Central Group is completely self supporting. We now have meetings on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Each meeting starts at 8:P.M., and ends at 9:P.M.
