Danny's vision was to have the meeting in the actual Cathedral (church) itself. He met Buddy in the parking lot out front across from the College. Buddy said follow me, we passed the Cathedral and Danny was thinking NO I want it in the Church. Buddy drove to the bottom of the Brown Roof Mansion and opened the door and asked if this would do? Danny instantly feel in love with the room. He later found out it was nicknamed The Stone Room. The room was used for a Speak Easy and to take Blue Prints off.

The group was named by Vinny R., Danny M. explained what the room looked like and Vinny said "Spiritual Foundation Group" On December 22, 2005 the first meeting was held Danny chaired and Richie Y. spoke for his 2 year anniversary. It was so close to Christmas that Richie came dressed as Santa Clause he played Santa for the kids earlier in the night. 10 addicts showed up and we collected \$44.00. On January 6th we celebrated New Years by hearing Dick speak and Tom C. chaired. On January 12th we held our first business meeting. We chose to go with Bucks County Area which we are still a part of and participating at area level today.

Our 1- year Anniversary Danny chaired. Al P. & Frank W. spoke, what a great meeting. We had 115 addicts and an unbelievable food spread. On July 27, 2006 we started a tradition with double speaker Outdoor Meetings, our first outdoor meeting Theresa T. chaired, Debbie & Tom C. spoke, we had 52 addicts attend. The outdoor meetings are in June, July & August of every summer, held on the back lawn. We have them on the 2nd & 4th Thursdays of the month. Our 2- year Anniversary Leo F. chaired. Stacey F. & Ian spoke, we had 73 addicts that night. Our 3- year Anniversary Mike H. chaired. Robin H. & Hannah spoke, what a great meeting. We had 110 addicts.

Terry & Danny M. spoke on NA History, what a unbelievable meeting. We had 75 addicts attend.

Joe B. with Scott S. started a meeting here in this building Harry E. came up with the name of the group and called it "Stones to Freedom Group" Sunday Night 7:30 and it's still running today. Colleen K., Mike H., left our home group and started a meeting here in this building and called it "Sunday Serenity" on Sunday Mornings at 10:00 am. it still goes on today. Jim H. started a meeting on Saturday Nights 7:00 pm and called it "The 3rd Tradition Meeting." it's still here in this building. Gary & Jill F. started a meeting on Tuesday Nights 8:30 and called it "It's Never to Late to Recover Meeting." Unfortunately it just closed recently.
